

What is *Pedals Around the World*?

The Pedals Around the World initiative began in 2002 as a pilot project of His Work in Progress, (HWIP.) Working in Bosnian refugee camps at that time, members of HWIP realized that bicycles could provide a reliable and inexpensive transportation for people who were rebuilding their lives. Since then, the project has spread to Peru, Mexico, and the Caribbean.

At the same time, the Pedals Around the World project allows bicycle donors the satisfaction of knowing that their bikes are going to people who will make good use of them, rather than just adding to landfills.

Pedals Around the World has worked locally to provide bicycles to children in foster care through the Tabor Services organization.
